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Information and Guidelines

Each competitor should bring the following items on the day of the tournament:

- Valid student ID
- Medical insurance coverage information
- Completed Cornell waiver form (enclosed)
- Tournament fee, as detailed below

Tournament Fee

For clubs registered with the ECTC, fees are \$30 per competitor. For clubs that have not registered with the ECTC, fees are \$40 per competitor. For competitor fees, please bring cash or a check made payable to "Sport Taekwondo at Cornell", NOT the ECTC.

If you would like to register with the ECTC, please fill out the form at <http://ectc-online.org/join.html> and either mail it to the address provided there, or you may bring the form and check made out to "Ivy Northeast Collegiate Taekwondo League" with you to the tournament. No money orders or cash please.

Competitor Qualification

- Must be a **full-time student** of a participating school.
- Must be currently enrolled in a participating club.
- Must wear a V-neck Tae Kwon Do dobok (uniform). Only black belts are allowed to wear uniforms with black trim around the collar.
- Must carry his/her medical insurance coverage information. Each competitor must bring his/her student college or university identification card.

Please be aware of the new A-team regulations effective this year: from the quarter finals on, all A-team matches will be fought using the Daedo/Truescore technology. Electronic hogus will be provided by the league but each competitor is responsible for his or her own Daedo e-socks, available online at <http://www.truescore.com>. B and C team divisions will not be affected by these changes.

Please be aware that due to new regulations, all teams are allowed to enter 4 black belt competitors in both the Men and Women Poomsae divisions.

Ithaca, NY 14853**

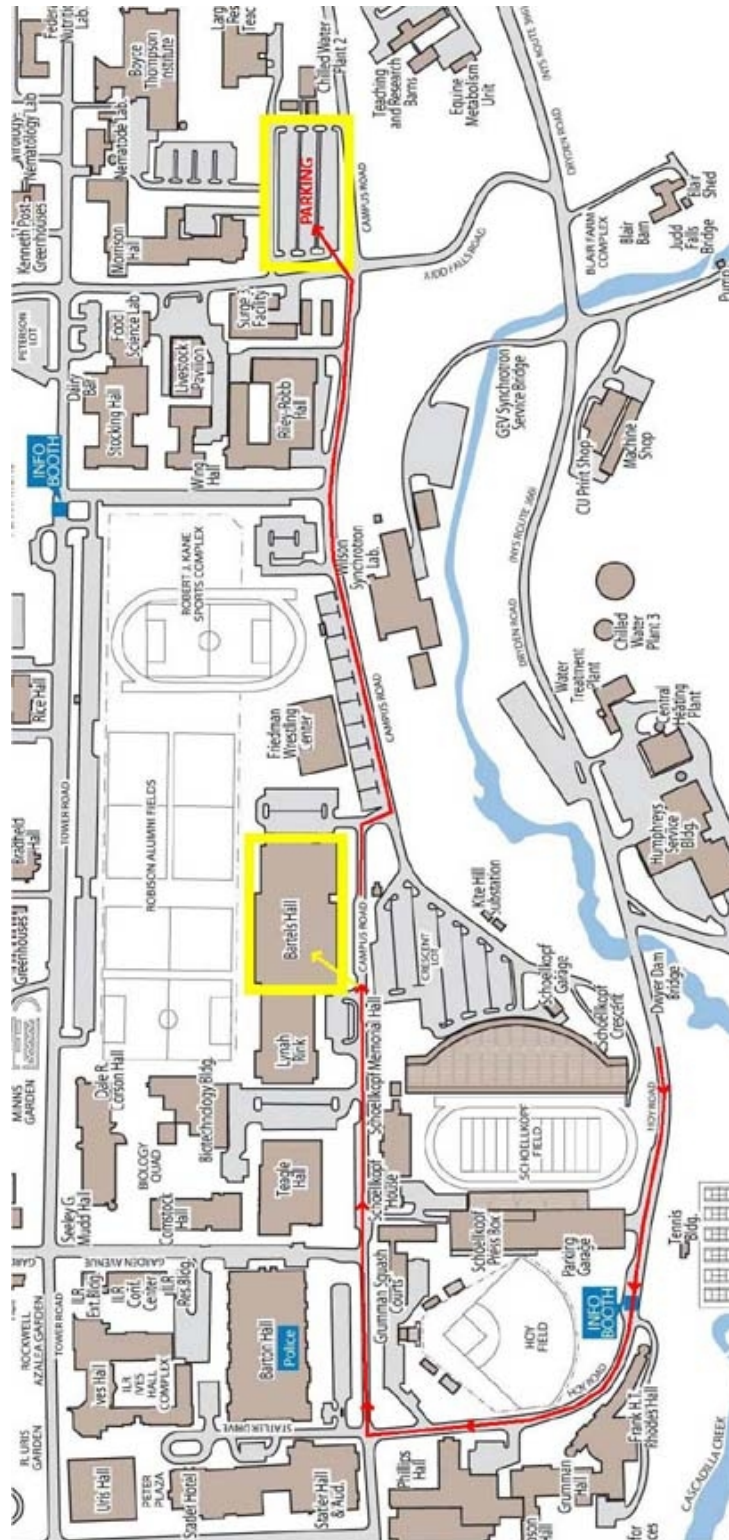

Enter campus via Hoy Road. From Hoy Road, turn right onto Campus Road. Go approximately ¼ mile, and Bartels Hall will be on your left. Competitors may enter Bartels Hall using either the south entrance (facing Campus Road) or the east entrance. The tournament will be held in the Ramin Room, which is at the east end of the building.

Parking will be available in the **South Morrison Lot** at the corner of Campus Road and Judd Falls Road, which is less than ½ mile past Bartels Hall.

Release of all claims and covenant not to sue

NOTICE: THIS IS A LEGALLY BINDING AGREEMENT. By signing this agreement you give up your right to bring a court action to recover compensation or obtain any other remedy for any injury to yourself or your property or for your death however caused arising out of your participation in the event name.

I HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE that the participation in Taekwondo has inherent risks. I have full knowledge of the nature and the extent of all the dangers and risks associated with **Taekwondo**, including but not limited to:

1. broken limbs;
2. death;
3. eye injuries;
4. facial injuries;
5. head injuries;
6. back injuries;

I further acknowledge that the above list is not inclusive of all possible risks associated with Taekwondo, and that the above list in no way limits the extent or reach of this release and covenant not to sue.

Release/indemnification and covenant Not to Sue

In consideration of my participation in the event name, I, the undersigned, agree, to indemnify and hold harmless club name and Cornell University, their officers, agents, and employees from any and all causes of action, claims, demands, losses or costs of any nature whatsoever arising out of or in any way relating to my participation in this event. I hereby certify that I have full knowledge of the nature and the extent of the risks inherent in Taekwondo and that I am voluntarily assuming the risks. I understand that I will be solely responsible for any loss or damage, including death, I sustain while participating and that by this agreement I am relieving club name and Cornell University, of any and all liability for such loss damage, or death.

I further certify that I am in good health and that I have no physical limitations which would preclude my safe participation.

I further certify that my date of birth is _____(month/ day/ year), that my present age is _____, and that I am therefore of lawful age (18 years or older) and otherwise legally competent to sign this agreement. I further understand that the terms of this agreement are legally binding and I certify that I am carefully signing this agreement, after carefully read the same, of my own free will.
