Tournament Rules:

This tournament will follow the ECTC rules found at ectc-online.org/rules.htm. Rules posted there supersede all information found in this packet.

Tournament Fee:

For competitors from a registered school:

\$30 per competitor, cash or checks made payable to "University of Vermont, Taekwondo Club".

For competitors from a non-registered school, or for those competitors who register after the deadline:

\$40 per competitor, cash or checks made payable to "University of Vermont, Taekwondo Club".

For competitors from a non-registered school and who are registering after the deadline:

\$50 per competitor, cash or checks made payable to "University of Vermont, Taekwondo Club".

To register a school/club with the ECTC for the current year, please mail club dues (\$100) and registration form found at the end of this packet to Master Dan Chuang, or bring the fee and registration form to the tournament (check only, no cash or money orders). Competitor Registration:

Registration for the University of Vermont ECTC tournament must be requested by Tuesday April 4th 2016 by 10pm. Your school will have until April 7th by 10pm to completely fill your form. To register, obtain a tournament registration spreadsheet at:

Competitors must provide:

- Valid, current Student ID
- Registration fee as described above
- Medical insurance information

Competitor Eligibility:

All competitors must be full time students at the time of the competition. While student ID's are used as proof of student enrollment, the ECTC reserves the right to request proof of full time status from the registrar of any school if there is a question about a student's full time status.

Directions:

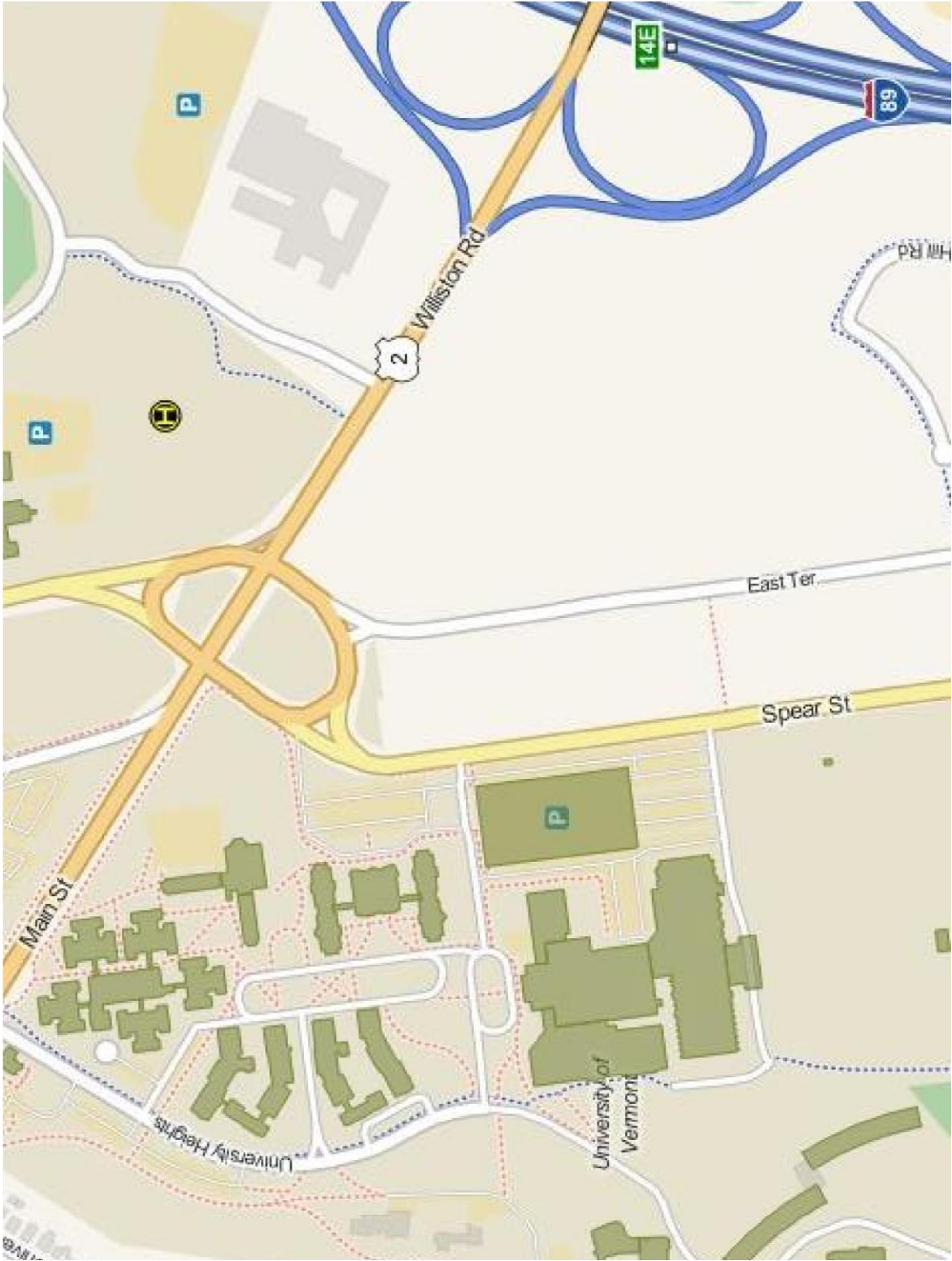
From I-89: Take Exit 14W into Burlington. Stay in far-right lane. Just past Sheraton and stop light, bear right at East Avenue/Spear Street exit, in lane for Spear Street. Take immediate left around jug handle, go through traffic light, which will take you onto Spear Street. Drive approximately 1/2 mile to second Patrick Gym entrance on right.

From Rout 7 North: Follow Route 7 North from Shelburne. Just past Denny's Restaurant and just before reaching Burlington, take I89 East. Travel approximately one mile to I-89 North. Continue using directions as above, from I-89 (Exit 14W is the second exit upon entering I-89 North).

Parking:

Parking at UVM is free on weekends in designated areas. Please see the attached map that designates parking (P).

Directions if coming from Spear Street: After turning right off of Spear Street drive straight and take the second left. Park on the top floor of the parking garage.

I, the below signed, am aware that playing or practicing any athletic activity can be a dangerous activity involving MANY RISKS OF INJURY. To the best of my knowledge, I am in good health and suffer no disability or condition which renders my participation in the sport or other athletic activity medically inadvisable, or otherwise limits my ability to participate in such sport or athletic activity without restriction.

I hereby authorize the coach (or other appropriate UVM personnel) to obtain on my behalf first aid, emergency medical care, or, if necessary, admission to an accredited hospital, when such care is necessary for the treatment of any injuries that I may sustain while participating in any activity associated with UVM club sports, including practices, games, and travel. I also hereby consent to the administration of emergency medical treatment in the event that I am unable subsequent to such injury to give such consent as otherwise necessary. **I agree to be responsible for all medical charges incurred by any hospitalization or treatment rendered pursuant to this authorization.**

In consideration for my participation in the sport and all activities related to the sport, including – but not limited to – practicing, competing, and traveling. I hereby voluntarily assume all risks associated with participation and agree to hold harmless UVM, its agents, officers, and employees, including – but not limited to – the athletics and club sports staff of UVM from any liability, claims, causes of action or demands of any kind and nature whatsoever which may arise by or in connection with my participation and any activities related to UVM club sports, except in the event of gross negligence.

The terms of this Agreement shall serve as a release and assumption of risk for my heirs, estate, executor, administrators, assignees, and all members of my family.
